Dear Costco Member,

Our records indicate you purchased a Cannondale bicycle from Costco between September 2012 and August 2014. These bicycles may be subject to a recall announced by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC).

This recall involves bicycles equipped with front disc brakes and a black or silver quick release lever on the front wheel hub. Bicycles that do not have disc brakes are not included in this recall.

According to the CPSC Recall Website (<http://www.cpsc.gov/en/Recalls/>):

An open quick release lever on the bicycle's front wheel hub can come into contact with the front disc brake rotor causing the front wheel to come to a sudden stop or separate from the bicycle, posing a risk of injury to the rider.

When the front quick release is fully opened, if there is less than 6 mm -- or the width of a #2 pencil -- between the quick release and disk brake rotor on the wheel, the bicycle is included in this recall.
