



Dear Costco Member,

Costco's records indicate that you have purchased one or more FUJIFILM FinePix XP90 and/or XP120 digital cameras (Costco Item #1040805, #1042277, #1042278, #1133855, #1135796 & #1136099) between June 2016 and January 2018.

Consumer safety is Fujifilm's top priority, so in cooperation with the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission, it has initiated a recall due to risk of electrical shock of certain AC-5VF power adapter wall plugs that were packaged with certain digital camera models manufactured by FUJIFILM Corporation in Japan and sold in the United States through FUJIFILM North America Corporation. While there have been no reported injuries, there is a risk that the wall plug may crack, break or detach and remain in the outlet exposing live electrical contacts and posing a shock hazard. Only wall plugs included with certain XP90 and XP120 digital cameras sold at Costco are subject to the recall. **Please confirm if your wall plug is affected by entering your camera's model name and serial number into the search tool found here: http://fujifilmusa.com/support/recall/index.html.** 

**Please immediately stop using any affected wall plug** and contact Fujifilm directly via email at **productsafety@fujifilm.com** or via their toll-free number <u>1-833-613-1200</u> to obtain a free replacement plug. Please note that your camera is not affected and you may continue to use your camera and charge the camera via the USB cable by connecting it to a personal computer.



Consumer safety is always Fujifilm's top priority. Fujifilm has voluntarily decided to exchange affected wall plugs free of charge and your cooperation is appreciated in exchanging and replacing your current wall plug and associated adapter.
